

# WESTERN CAREER PREP HIGH SCHOOL



Western Career Prep High School is a small learning environment where the individual learning needs of students are considered and valued. The focus of the school is to help students (16-20 years of age) earn a high school diploma while developing the skills needed for employment and/or post secondary educational opportunities.

A personalized career-focused curriculum is created for each student. The curriculum emphasizes rigor and provides students with opportunities to make the community a part of their learning environment through work study, job shadowing and other community based activities.

Students are challenged to be high achievers, self-motivated, self-directed and responsible individuals who make a positive impact on their community.
