



# Western Career Prep High School 2015-2016

### Program Overview:

- Students will complete all MME required curriculum credits and electives will have a Career Prep focus.
- Students must complete 26 credits to earn a Michigan High School diploma.

### Enrollment Process:

- Students entering Western Career Prep High School must be at least 16 years old and preferably have completed Freshman level core classes (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Language Arts) at a traditional high school.
- Students who have completed their Freshman level core classes will be given priority for enrollment over students who have not completed the courses.
